

# Chitwan Tour | Duration: 3 Days Days | Cost: \$220

Chitwan is Nepal's most famous wildlife reserve and one of the finest national park in Asia listed on world heritage sites. Its dense forests and grassy plains are home to rare mammals like one-horned rhinos and Bengal tigers. The park shelters 56 species of herpetofauna, 544 species of birds, 126 species of fish and 68 species of mammals to watch. The park is especially renowned for its protection of One Horned Rhinoceros, Royal Bengal Tiger and Gharial Crocodile. You will stay in a lodge with good views of the lush forested valley and the Rapti River for two nights or longer depend on your tour. You will visit a local village and learn how the villagers live in a sustainable manner. One can enjoy here Jeep safari, canoeing trip, jungle walk, visit ethnic local people, a cultural performance, etc. Exploring wildlife in its natural habitat is always an unforgettable experience. Get up early with sunrise, accompanied by a unique 'dawn chorus', you will penetrate the national park in the traditional way by your own feet and jeep safari. A naturalist guide helps you spot rhino, sloth bears, wild boar and if you're very lucky Royal Bengal tiger too. You return to the hotel for breakfast. You will also have an opportunity to watch the elephants bath in the river. After lunch, you will have the option of a trip by dugout canoe to see crocodile and birds and return on foot along the river bank, etc. Everyday Departure.

## Drive to Chitwan (approx. 5hrs)

You will have a scenic drive in tourist bus from Kathmandu to Chitwan for approximately 5hrs and will be picked by hotel representatives and check-in at hotel. After that you will get a briefing of tour. Walking tour of nearby village of Tharu community to explore the local life and culture. Dinner at evening and Cultural program of Tharu communities will end the first day of tour.

## Full day at Chitwan National Park

Early morning you will have a wakeup call and breakfast. In this day you will enjoy the nature walk, bird watching and canoeing which helps you to explore the different rare species like marsh crocodile and Gharial (fish-eating crocodile). If you would like to have an elephant ride then you can, but we would not recommend. Then after you will get lunch and some rest for the next session which will be jeep safari at National park. If you are lucky enough then you will explore Royal Bengal Tiger, different types of Deer, one horn rhinoceros, leopard, sloth bear, and many other wildlife creatures. Dinner in the evening.

## Half day at Chitwan and Drive back to Kathmandu

Early morning with a wake-up call, you will get breakfast and visit the elephant breeding center and bird watching at the national park. Drive back to Kathmandu.
